*Refunds will **not** be given for failure to pick up your order on the designated day/time. If you cannot pick up your order, you must make arrangements for it to be picked up. We have no way to hold your fish.
*The District is not responsible for any mortality of stock which may occur during transport from our location.

Stocking Recommendations:

- Black Crappie-** 100-200 per surface acre. Stock with largemouth bass to help control Crappie population.
- Bass** – 100 fingerlings per surface acre (4-6" are slightly larger than a fingerling, so stocking can be cut by half. Max pond temp. during summer is 75-85°F. Pond depth should be 6-8 feet.
- Minnows** – 10-20lbs (2,000-4,000 minnows) per surface acre.
- Channel Catfish** – 100 per surface acre. Channel Catfish will reach approximately 2ft in length at maturity. They are semi-aggressive so be mindful if you plan to have them in swimming ponds and they will live approximately 8 years. We do not suggest this species for ponds less than a half-acre in size.
- Trout** – 200 per surface acre. Max pond temp. during summer is 65-70°F. Pond depth should be 8-10ft. Should not be stocked with Bass.
